The health, safety, care and comfort of your pet is our primary concern. We strive to offer superior quality and professional grooming services for all pets.

We recognize the special bond that clients share with their pets and along with their owners; we value their health and well being.

We understand that your pet has many emotions and we will take into consideration the effect a grooming visit may have on them. Most pets, while visiting a grooming salon enjoy their time here and love the attention they receive from their groomer.

We are aware that some pets may sometimes suffer from anxiety, nervousness and become a little distressed while visiting a grooming salon. We will nurture and understand your pet's feelings and ensure that your pet feels comfortable at all times.

Difficult Dogs

Dogs that show a tendency to bite or jump around may be muzzled or attached to a grooming arm for their safety and ours. Dogs that are uncontrollable may not be able to be groomed. In our experience this is a rare occurrence. If however your pet is extremely distressed, a mild sedation may be administered, under veterinary care.

Senior Pets & Pets with Health Problems

Once your pet becomes elderly or infirm they may not accept a lengthy grooming procedure. For their comfort and safety they will be groomed for cleanliness and comfort, in simple styles.

Mat Removal

When we are removing fur mats we are extremely careful to ensure that the skin isn't cut or nicked. However sometimes we may find that underneath the matts are skin tags, warts and moles. We may also find that removal of the matt reveals skin irritations caused by moisture trapped near the skin allowing mould, fungus or bacteria to grow. Clipping may also reveal embedded grass seeds

Veterinary Care

Every effort is made to ensure your pet's grooming is a pleasant and safe experience. In the unlikely event that your pet becomes ill during grooming and requires veterinary attention, permission for treatment would be required. The costs of such veterinary treatment would be paid by the owner.

How Often Should My Pet Be Groomed

The duration of time between professional grooming can vary greatly between dogs of the same breed. Coat condition, hair type, density and climate are just some of the variables. A lot depends on how much brushing or grooming that you are able to offer your pet at home.

Here are some guidelines suggested by Grooming Authorities. As a professional groomer, we can be more specific about your pet. If you don't brush or comb regularly, choose the earlier time frame.

Carin/Westie	6-12 weeks
Cocker/Springer	6-8 weeks
Collie	6-8 weeks
Golden Retriever	8-12 weeks
Shih-tzu	6-8 weeks
Maltese	4-8 weeks
Old English	6-10 weeks
Pomeranian	12-16 weeks
Poodle (all sizes)	4-8 weeks
Schnauzer (all sizes)	6-10 weeks
Scottish Terrier	6-10 weeks
Fox Terrier	6-8 weeks
Yorkshire Terrier	6-8 weeks
